

Ragmi Mustafa was born on May 18, 1962, in the village of Zujince, the municipality of Presevo. He's married and has three children.

On May 17, 2003, he was elected Leader of the Democratic Party of Albanians (DPA) in Presevo for a four-year term of office. On May 13, 2007, he was re-elected Leader of the Presevo-based DPA for a four-year term of office.

He graduated from the Faculty of Electrical Engineering – Electronics Department – of the Pristina University in 1987. From 1987 until 2004, he worked as a teacher of information technology at the “Skenderbeg” grammar school in Presevo. In November 2004, he was elected President of the Municipal Assembly of Presevo, while in June 2006, he was re-elected Mayor of Presevo at the local elections. On May 11, 2008, he was elected President of the Municipal Assembly and he occupied that position until May 20, 2009, when he was re-elected Mayor of Presevo.

He has been on a study trip to the Czech Republic so far. He is in touch with the Serbian government's ministries and ministers, the Coordination Body of the Government of the Republic of Serbia for the municipalities of Presevo, Bujanovac and Medvedja, as well as with almost all ambassadors of foreign countries that are accredited to Belgrade. He cooperates with representatives of local self-governments through the “East West Institute”. He is also involved in the micro– regional cross - border cooperation between Presevo, Gnjilane, Kumanovo and Trgoviste. He cooperates with all international donors, such as with the UNDP, USAID, CHF, HELP etc, by working on infrastructure investment projects and on economic development of the municipality of Presevo.
