



Slobodan Drašković was born of father Momir and mother Milica on September 28, 1962, in the village of Vrapac, which is situated in the municipality of Medvedja. He's an economist by profession. He's married and the father of one child. He began his career on September 14, 1989, at the "Vladimir Bukilic" elementary school, where he worked as a teacher until April 1, 1993. As of 1993, he was employed at the Ministry of Defense's department in Medvedja. From December 1, 1996, until November 11, 2000, he held the position of Vice President of the Municipal Assembly in Medvedja, after which he was appointed President of the Municipal Assembly in Medvedja. He was elected Mayor of Medvedja at the first direct elections held in July 2002. Upon expiry of his term of office, he was re-elected Mayor of Medvedja in the first round of the elections that were held in June 2006. He has been at the mayoral position ever since. In addition, he's Vice President of the Serbian government's Coordination Body for the Municipalities of Presevo, Bujanovac and Medvedja and is also a member of several district organs and bodies.
